Generic Conditions of Play Bowls Manawatu

TeamsSpecify number in squad e.g. 1 x 10 person team per genderSpecify disciplines e.g. Singles, Pairs, Triples, Fours

 Format
 x rounds of play using a scattered/ team draw

 Scattered Draw
 There is no freedom of movement allowed between disciplines. Players' positions may be changed within a discipline but not between disciplines.

OR

Team Draw - Freedom of movement permitted between disciplines. The Managers or Representatives of the side toss a coin before commencement of play for all games in each round.

Scoring: Result determined by wins (1 point), and draws (0.5 point). If equal points then on number of ends won. If still equal then on differential.

Restricting the Movement of Players during Play:

Singlesthe opponents after delivery of their 3rd and 4th bowlsPairsthe Leads after delivery of their 3rd bowlsthe Skips after delivery of their 2nd and 3rd bowlsTriplesthe Leads and Seconds after delivery of their 2nd bowlthe Skips after delivery of each of their bowls

Fours the Leads after the second player in their team has delivered their 2nd bowl the Seconds and Thirds after delivery of their 2nd bowl the Skips after delivery of each of their bowls
2x4x2 the first player after the delivery of their 2nd bowl the player playing 4 bowls, after the delivery of their 3rd & 4th bowl the player playing the last 2 bowls, after delivery of each of their bowls

In exceptional and limited circumstances a Singles player can ask the Marker for permission to walk up to the head, or a Skip can ask that a player walks up to the head earlier than described above.

General Conditions:

- All games are to be played in accordance with Laws of the Sport of Bowls, NZ Domestic Regulations and Conditions of Play.
- The Controlling Body/ Tournament Manager shall have the right to alter or amend the schedule and/or playing conditions as deemed necessary.
- Should bowls stickers be used all team bowls must have stickers.
- Scorecards are to be filled in including the names of players and to be signed by both skips at the completion of the game.
- Smoking/ vaping is not permitted on/near the green during the event. Host's club smoking policy to be adhered to.
- Phones are to be switched off or turned to silent mode.
- A Manager's meeting will be held at (insert time etc)
- <u>Catering</u>: Specify e.g. Players to provide own lunch
- <u>Results</u>: Specify e.g. Will be live scored and available on Bowls Kapiti Coast website www.sporty.co.nz/bowlskapiti/draws /results/all events/

In the event of weather stopping play..... Is it possible to specify how many ends constitute a completed game, or how many rounds constitute a completed tournament?

Advice from local umpires is that this can only be decided on a case by case basis – difficult to generalise.
